

Young Adult Room Policy

The Dixon Homestead Library is committed to providing an inviting and safe space for teenage patrons to engage in individual and group activities. The social nature and unique characteristics of this age group require a separate space designed for their needs.

The Young Adult Room is designated for use by students in grades 6-12 and/or ages 12-18. Patrons who fall outside those grade and age categories may be asked to leave the room before school lets out (2PM). Library-owned technology resources in the Young Adult Room are reserved solely for use by young adults.

Young adults are expected to respect the overall Library environment, and may not engage in activities or communications that disrupt other Library users or staff. All other Library policies apply to the YA Room. The Dixon Homestead Library reserves the right to limit the use of the library by young adults who, in the judgment of the library staff, are infringing upon the rights of other library users by inappropriate behavior. The Code of Conduct Policy applies to all patrons in the Young Adult Room.

The conducting of tutoring is prohibited in the Young Adult Room.
